OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS FOR MELNOR® TIME-A-MATIC® ELECTRONIC WATER TIMER MODEL NO. 100

STEP 1: INSERTING BATTERIES

To install batteries, remove screw, then pull bottom cover from timer. Place two (2) "AA" Alkaline batteries (not included) according to "+" and "-" markings (as shown on bottom cover). Replace cover and screw. Valve may move upon installation of batteries. Timer must be reset.

Note: If batteries were incorrectly installed, timer will not function at all.

STEP 2: RESETTING TIMER

Open top cover. Press key and release. Your will observe:

• A gear sound as valve moves to its "OFF" position. Slow opening and closing of valve helps prevent water hammer.

Two short "beeps".

- 2. Press OFF The valve will move to the "OFF" position and a single short beep will be heard. The water passage is closed

Note: Please male sure that the valve is in the "OFF" position prior to programming.

PROGRAMMING YOUR TIMER

STEP 3: SETTING A DELAYED WATERING PROGRAM A. WATERING START TIME:

Press (STANTING) key. If immediate watering is desired, see Note on reverse side for programming instructions. One beep will sound with each press and indicates an increment of one (1) hour. Continue pressing key to advance time. Watering starts with a delay of one (1) hour up to twelve (12) hours from present time. Example: Present time is 1:30 PM and you press [WATERING] once. Start time will be 2:30 PM.

With each pressing of key, start time will advance in one (1) hour increments. At twelfth (12th) key entry, a long beep will sound. This indicates that you have reached maximum delay and twelve (12) hours from now, watering will begin. If you want to start earlier, you must press RESET and reprogram the timer with the desired start time, using less than twelve (12) key presses. Press RESET for desired start time.

TWO (2) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Melnor®Time-A-Matic® Electronic Water Timer (Model # 100) carries a TWO YEAR (2) LIMITED WARRANTY. Melnor, Inc. warrants the Product against defective material, workmanship or design for the period of two years from the date of purchase. Its liability under this warranty shall be LIMITED TO THE REPLACEMENT OR REPAIR of the product as provided herein. NO OTHER REMEDY (including, but not limited to incidental or consequential damages and injuries to persons or property) shall be available to the purchaser. This warranty does not cover damages or malfunctions which result from abuse, neglect, normal wear and tear, accidents or improper installation or use. THE WARRANTY DESCRIBED IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IN LIEU OF ANY OTHER WARRANTY EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

If a defect arises during the **TWO (2) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY PERIOD**, in order to make your warranty claim, please send the Timer to the address on the warranty card and include a note of explanation about the problem(s) with the Product. Please allow 6-7 weeks for return of the Product. If it is replaced, the warranty will only continue for the period remaining on the original two year limited warranty.

B. WATERING DURATION:

Press (WATERING) key. One beep will sound with each key press and indicates an increment of fifteen (15) minutes. Continue pressing key to advance time. Watering stops within fifteen (15) minutes up to three (3) hours from start time. Example: Start time is 2:30 PM and you press (WATERING) once. Stop time will be 2:45 PM.

With each pressing of key, stop time will advance in fifteen (15) minutes increments. At twelfth (12th) key entry, a long beep will sound. This indicates that you have reached maximum duration of watering which is three (3) hours. If you want a shorter watering period you must press reser and reprogram the timer with the shorter duration, using less than twelve (12) key presses. Press watering for desired stop time.

C. SINGLE/REPEAT FUNCTION:

Pressing the NUMBLE REPEAT REY ONCE gives you a one-day-only (single) watering cycle. Pressing this key twice VERY QUICKLY IN SUCCESSION gives you the same watering cycle every day (repeat) until program is changed. For a REPEAT cycle, you must press NUMBLE REPEAT REP

D. REVIEWING WATERING START TIME AND DURATION:

Immediately after entry of Single/Repeat function, automatic review for watering start time and duration is activated. A series of 1-second interval "beeps" will be heard, indicating the watering start time you have entered. After a pause of 1-2 seconds, a series of 1/2 second interval "beeps" will be heard, indicating the watering duration you have entered. Now press SINGLE as desired. Verify entries for watering start time and duration.

E. REVIEWING SINGLE/REPEAT FUNCTION:

key press verifies your selection. One (1) "beep" will be heard if the Single function has been selected. Two (2) "beeps" will be heard if the Repeat function has been selected. Now press SINGLE to verify.

NOTE: If you wish to change your program or made an error during programming, press RESET and repeat Step 3.

STEP 4: CONNECTING TIMER TO OUTSIDE FAUCET

Tighten the coupling nut onto the faucet, keeping the top cover of the timer facing up. Be careful, **DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN!**After the timer is installed, connect a garden hose to the outlet end of the timer. Turn the faucet on to allow water flow. If you wish to remove the timer from the faucet, turn the faucet off. Press ON TO TURN TO THE TO T

NOTE: FOR IMMEDIATE WATERING WITH PROGRAMMED SHUT-OFF

Press RESET to activate timer. Press WATERING for desired duration. Each key that you press represents an increment of fifteen (15) minutes up to (3) hours duration. Then, press SINGLE one time. You will hear a review beep and the valve will open immediately. NOTE: After using IMMEDIATE WATERING, the timer must be reprogrammed. Follow steps No. 2 and 3.

OPTIONAL FEATURE: MANUAL ON/OFF

This feature allows you to turn the water on and off at any time except after a single cycle is completed.

Press of to start watering immediately. A single "beep" will be heard. To stop watering, press of the heard. To stop watering, press of the heard. Watering will resume at the next scheduled time as previously programmed.

If a single cycle has been completed, press RESET to use Manual On/Off.
